

# HOLO-FLOOR 2 DECORATIVE FLOOR FILM

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What type of floor systems does this film work well on?**

All types – wood, vinyl, marble, granite. Typically, this is used with any type of portable dance floor system. Other surfaces include walls, sets, displays, etc.

### **Can it be applied then transported on dance floor panels?**

Absolutely. Most floors the film is used on is either 3 X 3 ft. or 3 X 4 ft. interlocking tiles - vinyl surface. Some have used it on parquet and similar style floors as well. Just have to be aware that some of the wood pattern will show thru on the film after its applied. Won't diminish the look but not as smooth as vinyl. Some don't care either way. We believe that the best way to do this and achieve success is to prep in advance (most times off-site) and bring to the site and assemble.

### **Will it rip with all night dancing?**

No. In some cases, the floor can be used more than once. This is a polyester vinyl based film. The only way to rip it or tear it is with a knife or other sharp objects. Since its debut back in January at the Special Event Opening Night party in Dallas where over the course of several hours, with roller blade troupe performance on the floor and others -not to mention hundreds dancing on it all night - the only "damage" were heal scuff marks!

### **Do you have a rep that could come and apply it on sight?**

No. The concept behind the product is that anyone can do it...and have. It comes with instructions and literally impossible to make a mistake.

### **How long does it take to install the film on a dance floor?**

Depending on size but for a 30 ft. X 30 ft. floor, it would take two people about one day to install. The installation on portable dance floor tiles is best done in advance. We suggest applying the film to each individual panel and then transport and set up at the site. The floor should be the last component installed to avoid other vendors from walking and moving equipment across the floor. A protective surface such as painters plastic will also help keep the floor looking good until the doors open.

### **Does the Holo-Floor 2 film leave a residue and how easy is it to remove?**

The film is made with a special adhesive designed for floor graphics. It is very easily removed and because the adhesive is designed to for floors, it will not leave any residue or damage the floor surface in any way. However, the floor itself needs to be up to factory specification for it work properly. In fact, on properly prepared and primed, painted walls, the film can also be safely used without removing paint, etc.

### **How is sold, by the roll, sheet?**

We have over 12 different patterns that you can choose from and is shipped in 50 or 100 ft. rolls. Most rolls are 38 in. wide but we do have a few patterns that are 51 in. wide. To calculate how many rolls you will need for your floor, it is best to figure it out by square foot. For example, if you have a 30 X 30 ft. floor, that is 900 sq. ft. For a 38 in. wide roll (3.2 ft.), you would need approximately 300 ft. of film or 3 rolls.
